## APPLICATION PROCESS

### OVERSEAS HOST INSTITUTIONS

Host Institutions submit **project proposals** to Fulbright Commission or U.S. Embassy in their country



**Project proposals are reviewed and approved by the Fulbright Commission/ U.S. Embassy and the U.S. Department of State**

### U.S. ACADEMICS AND PROFESSIONALS

Prospective Specialists submit **online applications** on a rolling basis to join the Fulbright Specialist Roster



**Individuals approved by peer review panels are admitted to the Fulbright Specialist Roster for a duration of three years**



Based on their professional experience and academic credentials, qualified **candidates from the Roster are matched to projects by World Learning** and approved by the Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board

The Fulbright Program is the U.S. government's flagship international educational and cultural exchange program. For more than 73 years, the Fulbright Program has offered opportunities for passionate and accomplished individuals of all backgrounds.
